Mr. Bauer discussed the JFS project. Mr. Tkach stated that what they were quoted at 60 months is actually 5% this is how the math works out. Mr. Bauer stated they used 2.9 %, Mr. Welch stated it depends on when you lock in, but the example they used was at 5%.

There are some points in the MOU that Mr. Fegley is not fond of that Mr. Binette has written regarding if the sales tax goes into a crisis like 2008-2009, to get the bills paid, if the money isn't there to prioritize it, then it doesn't have to be paid.
