#### **DECEMBER 13, 2018**

The Board of Huron County Commissioners met this date in Special Session to conduct regular business. Roll being called found the following members present: Terry Boose, Joe Hintz, Bruce Wilde.

Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 305.14 the Record of the Proceedings of the November 20, 2018, November 27, 2018, November 30, 2018, December 4, 2018 and December 6, 2018 meeting(s) were presented to the Board. Joe Hintz made the motion to waive the reading of the minutes of the November 20, 2018, November 27, 2018, November 30, 2018, December 4, 2018 and December 6, 2018 meeting(s) and approve as presented. Bruce Wilde seconded the motion. Voting was as follows:

Aye – Terry Boose Aye – Joe Hintz Aye – Bruce Wilde

At 9:05 a.m. Public Comment – John Popa, Richmond Township resident spoke about the wind project. In the footprint of the Emerson Creek Project, they will have 3 on their road. Seneca wind will have turbines about a ½ mile from his home. Mr. Popa stated that they are all for clean energy however they feel that the wind farms are not for them. Mr. Popa stated he would like to know if the lease holders are they really thinking environmental side or just the money side. Mr. Boose asked which phase will he be in, Mr. Popa stated phase 2. Mr. Boose stated that a discussion has not happened regarding a Pilot program with this project, only discussion that has happened on a Pilot is for the Greenwich project which is a totally different project. Mr. Boose stated that the size of the turbines will be determined by the Ohio Power Siting Board. Mr. Boose stated that the location of these turbines is not determined by the landowner or farmer, they are determined by where the best place is for the wind. Mr. Boose stated that the Pilot program that they have approved is due to all the local governments asking the Commissioners to do it this way as opposed to the straight tax situation. It is making it easier for them to budget this. Mr. Boose stated this is the only decision the Commissioners make.

Mr. Boose stated that Swift Energy has contacted him about meeting with him about a Pilot in the Greenwich project.

Mr. Wilde stated they have looked at all the letters sent, Mr. Wilde has one question regarding the setbacks Mr. Popa mentioned in his letter, he would like clarification from Mr. Popa regarding if the setback was 1500ft. it would help with flicker and they would feel much better regarding these. Mr. Hintz stated that the Commissioners cannot stop a turbine company from coming into the county. The Commissioners do not have any control over this. Mr. Hintz explained that he was on the board when the original wind lab came in, Mr. Hintz stated that they did not approve a Pilot or Alternative Energy Zone for this project. Mr. Hintz stated that they will not be a approving an alternative energy zone for this project either. Mr. Hintz stated that he is not personally crazy about this project, but if a community wants this who is he to stop this. Mr. Hintz stated that he went to VanWert to see the windfarms there, and even spoke with some people down there, and they were in favor of this project. Mr. Popa stated he is concerned about accidents on his road and tearing it up, Mr. Boose stated that if they do Pilot project they have control over the road due to a RUMA agreement.

Mr. Boose stated he doesn't the cell phone allowance and what we are paying, for the month of December under child support we paid \$79.52. Mr. Boose doesn't understand why cell phone expenses are so high. Mr. Hintz stated it says cell phones, hopefully its more than one phone bill.

Mr. Boose stated that he had a question regarding the electric bill for 22 E. Main St. until he spoke to Ms. Ziemba whom reminded him that 22 E. Main St. is all electric including heat.

Mr. Boose stated that he feels that we still need to shop for tires regarding replacements for the cruisers. Mr. Boose understands that these are supposed to be better tires.

Mr. Boose would like the Sheriff to review the fuel purchases for the jail. Mr. Boose stated you can make a lot of trips for the \$1,000 a month that we are spending on fuel. This just seems very high to him. Mr. Wilde asked does this include the Sheriff picking up prisoners and bringing them back, Mr. Boose stated no that doesn't include that.

Mr. Boose asked about the airport farm rent, Ms. Ziemba stated that the farmer pays twice a year and the airport gets the money once a year.

Mr. Boose asked what a dog warden application is, Ms. Ziemba stated it could be for the dog licenses.

Mr. Boose asked do we reimburse everyone for CDL Expenses from the Auto Tax Administration Line. Ms. Ziemba will send an email to get clarification.

Mr. Boose stated he will have to abstain from Norwalk Concrete payment.

Mr. Boose stated we paid VASU for an EMA Weather Station in the \$2,194.96, why do we need such a elaborate station? Mr. Boose stated this seems like a lot of money.

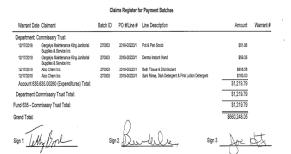

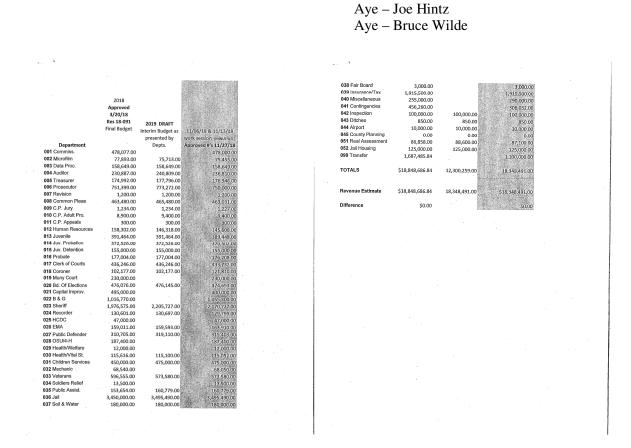

#### Administrator/Clerk report

Ms. Ziemba discussed the end of the year evaluations. Ms. Ziemba would like to know who will be evaluating who. Ms. Ziemba will be evaluating Ms. Martinson and Ms. Stebel. Ms. Ziemba stated the suggestions were Mr. Hintz would evaluate Mr. Brown and Mr. Ousley. Mr. Wilde would evaluate Mr. Mead and Ms. Minor and Mr. Boose would evaluate Ms. Ziemba and Mr. Welch. Mr. Hintz would like to evaluate Mr. Ousley and Mr. Welch and Mr. Boose will evaluate Ms. Ziemba and Mr. Brown.

Ms. Ziemba received a request from the Prosecutor's office they had some reimbursements/refunds from cancelling their contract with Spectrum along with something with their copier, received a refund from a book publisher the total amount is \$712.08 that was deposited into the General Fund. They are asking for this money to be placed back into their accounts. Ms. Ziemba stated they did not state what they need it for but \$62.40 would go into the repairs line, \$587.00 would go into the equipment line, \$140.93 into supplies library line. Mr. Strickler stated that when they got their color copier they received it for the same amount as their black and white copier therefore they were reimbursed 587.00. Mr. Strickler stated that they feel it is the reimbursement of their money and it is not something that is needed. Mr. Strickler stated to do this the right way, they should go to the Auditor and get an amended certificate to get this money moved.

Mr. Ziemba stated that back in October 16, 2018 Ms. Bond and Mr. Mead came before the board and the board gave them permission to purchase (3) dispatcher desks from Sandusky County not to exceed \$11,000, the bill came in and it is \$12,000.00. Ms. Ziemba stated she asked Ms. Bond why it was over, Ms. Bond stated she miscalculated. Ms. Ziemba stated that they already have the desks, Ms. Ziemba would like to know is it ok to pay the additional \$1,000 and if so she will need a motion and second.

Mr. Boose asked we paid \$11,000 for (3) new desks, Ms. Ziemba stated that these are used dispatcher desks and the cost of purchasing new desks would have been much more expensive. Mr. Boose stated that in the beginning of the year after everyone has their assignments and are moving forward he highly recommends that someone sit down with EMA/911 and discuss their spending habits. Ms. Ziemba stated that Ms. Bond told her that when the Board approved the desks, the board had also approved up to \$5,000 for carpeting. They were able to get the carpeting for \$2,500. Mr. Boose stated this is his personal opinion, the scenario they used for this, if everyone used this we would not have a carryover. Ms. Ziemba stated that when they found out they miscalculated they should have come before the board to let them know about this. The board agrees they need to discuss their spending habits.

Mr. Boose stated that two people who have called about renting 22 East Main St. They are asking about parking spaces. Mr. Boose not willing to give up more than two. Mr. Wilde not sure he wants to give up any.

Mr. Boose talked to Mayor Duncan and the Chamber after the HCDC meeting about what needs to be done to cover up the sign from when the antique mall removed the sign. Mr. Boose stated that they need to talk with Mitch Loughton to find out the requirements.

Mr. Boose stated he had two people come to him last week stating that the commissioners are kicking senior enrichment out of the parking lot. Mr. Boose informed them that is not what is happening. They are being asked to find a different location as soon as they can because they have outgrown the lot. Mr. Boose will attempt to attend their meeting tonight to inform them of the misinformation and ask them to correct the information out there.

At 12:32 p.m. Bruce Wilde moved to adjourn. Terry Boose seconded the motion. The meeting stood adjourned.
