Mr. Boose stated that Thursday is the meeting with John Airhart at 11:00 a.m. Mr. Boose updated the board on the Webinar on the 18<sup>th</sup> for Janice vs ASCME. Ms. Ziemba and Mr. Welch should be there.

Mr. Boose stated there is a CCAO Board of Directors meeting on the 20<sup>th</sup>.

Mr. Boose discussed the House Bill 366, he stated anytime there is a change in child support, be prepared.

Mr. Boose stated that there is a House Bill 312 credit card use policies, would like to make sure Mr. Brown is aware of it and needs to look into our policies.

<u>At 10:00 a.m.</u> Timothy Nyman, ES Consulting. Mr. Nyman stated they have been handling most of the county's IT needs, but everything is very pricey. Mr. Nyman would like to consolidate to save the county some money. Mr. Boose asked if they would be willing to come to an elected officials meeting to have an open discussion about county IT. Mr. Nyman stated that would be fine.

Mr. Nyman stated that most departments limp along because they haven't budgeted for IT problems. With this they can set up a program that IT is covered over the entire county. Therefore, when something breaks they will come in and fix it at no extra cost. Mr. Nyman stated the more hardware, software, etc. they buy, the cheaper they can get it which also saves the county money.

Mr. Boose explained that a lot of departments have maintenance agreements on software. That would need to continue for the specialized software. Mr. Nyman stated they would take a look at the software

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and figure out what the best way to go is, some of it they can handle.

Mr. Boose stated he is not sure if they would be able to do it for everybody in the county. Mr. Nyman stated JFS has to have IT through the state of Ohio for example. Some departments have already entered into a contract. Mr. Nyman stated previously they have treated each department as a separate business entity and they would like to treat it as a whole.

Mr. Nyman stated there are a lot of people who are not specialized in technology making technology decisions. ES Consulting acquired Information Technologies, and they still have a local office. The support level went up significantly with ES Consulting.

Mr. Boose would like to have that meeting with the elected officials late July or early August. He thinks the feedback will be positive, and it will give them a chance to meet them and ask questions. Mr. Boose stated there will be a little bit of politics in it because people like to keep control. And then after that meeting we will know how to move forward. A uniform platform across all departments will make things so much easier. The board will try to figure out some possible dates for the elected officials meeting.

Mr. Nyman stated that there are some disaster preparedness plan/recovery solution is being discussed in some of the departments. That would be part of the IT plan moving forward. Mr. Nyman stated the cost individually would be a department's entire budget, but the county as a whole would give the county significant discounts.

At 10:30 a.m. the board recessed.
