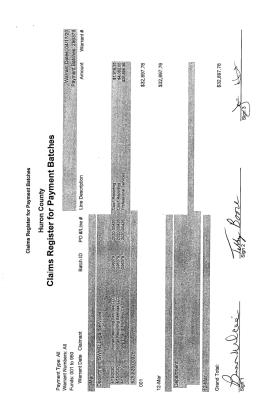

She read the email from the Secretary of State: HB197 included a \$7 million appropriation to the Secretary of State's office for the purposes of implementing the changes to the 2020 Primary Election described in Directive 2020-07. Aside from a portion of this funding that will be used to send an informational postcard to every registered voter in the state, Secretary LaRose has directed that these funds be used to assist counties with implementing these changes.

Each county will receive a check for \$10,000 as soon as possible to assist with up-front costs. Counties will also be eligible to receive additional funding on a reimbursement basis for the following types of costs:

Eligible costs for reimbursement:

- Vote by mail printing
- Vote by mail postage
- Secure receptacle for the return of ballots
- Vote by mail equipment
- Temporary elections staffing
- Cleaning supplies, protective masks and equipment
