WHEREAS, any unspent allocations within a county at the end of a fiscal year revert back to the state for use by the State Department of Job & Family Services: and

WHEREAS, a county family services agency must make such inter-county adjustment requests to the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services and include with such requests a resolution authorizing such from that county's board of commissioners and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 5101: 9-6-82 (F) (3) (a), a board of county commissioners may pass a resolution assigning authority to the director of the county family service agency to serve as their designee and therefore grant that part authority to sign the inter-county adjustments agreement on behalf of the county for a specific period of time: now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Huron County Commissioners hereby assigns authority to Lenora Minor, Director of Huron County Department of Job & Family Services, to serve as the Huron County Commissioners designee and herby grants Lenora Minor the authority to sign Inter-County Adjustments on behalf of Huron County for the specified period of calendar year 2020, with the understanding that a summary of such adjustments shall be provided to the Board of Huron County Commissioners prior to signing such agreement.
