

Thank you for your letter in regards to your lease agreement on the building located at the Huron County Airport.

The Board of Huron County Commissioners met on Tuesday, October 13, 2015 to discuss your letter with the advisement of Melissa James, Airport Board member. The Board of Huron County Commissioners collectively agreed that we currently do not have the funding to buy out your lease and questioned whether this would be a wise use of taxpayer dollars. This land and building would be a great asset to the county and the Board of Huron County Commissioners would welcome terminating the lease if you simply wish to get out of the lease. Unfortunately the Board of Huron County Commissioners cannot buy out the lease at this time. The Airport Board has one request if we do not terminate this lease, and that is to notify them of the amount of money you are receiving from each tenant, therefore they can be assured you are in compliance with the lease in the Assignment and Subletting portion of the agreement. You may contact Melissa James, Airport Board Member to keep that information confidential. You consideration in this matter is appreciated. Sincerely,

Gary Bauer reported on the meeting that took place on Wednesday, October 14, 2015 with Warren Brown, HR/LP, Doug Foust, Joe Kovach, Huron County Engineer, and staff and himself in regards to the health insurance plan. Mr. Bauer stated that us changing is not a problem, the problem is there has to be a significant adjustment on how/what the Engineer's Office does with their employees. Mr. Bauer stated the bottom line is we will make an official stated on Tuesday to join CEBCO, then soon thereafter Warren Brown and Doug Foust will need to get things rolling, in 60-70 days the Commissioners will need to make a decision on which insurance plans they will offer. Mr. Bauer explained that there are (3) HSA's, one is a very cheap plan, and no one uses through CEBCO, second is a plan with \$750.00 single, \$1500.00 family, third \$1250.00 single, \$2500.00 family. The Engineer's Office will suggest before Tuesday's meeting which direction they prefer to go, however the Commissioners make the final decision. Mr. Bauer explained that they received an email from Doug Foust explaining an 11% decrease in rates from what they received a few weeks ago. Mr. Bauer stated that if they stay with MMO it would cost 3.9 million dollars, with CEBCO it would cost 3.6 million dollars with the 11% decrease.
