



Mr. Bauer stated that April's sales tax was about \$45,000 higher than last year and found that interesting because January was about the same as 2009, February was almost as much, March was considerably more than 2009 and even though it is the right side of the issue which is very good it doesn't give you any reason to get excited about too much money. Mr. Bauer stated that he was talking to an automobile dealer yesterday in the county who said that they had just had a very good first quarter of the year and compared to other years had sold pretty much what they would expect to sell. This does not show up on this report the cars are not carrying their end of the sales tax and have not been.
