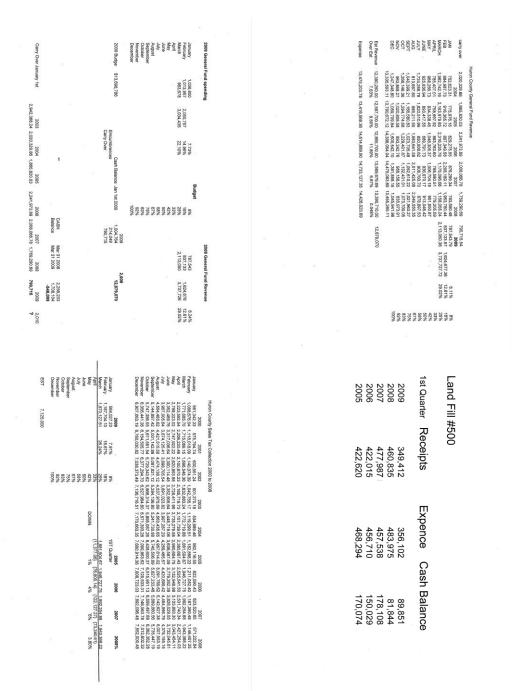
APRIL 2, 2009

Mike Adelman reported on the courthouse security meeting and stated that the camera system is considerably less than originally anticipated. Mr. Adelman also referred to an invitation from ODOT cordially inviting the board to the construction season meeting. April 8, 2009 1:30 p.m. in Ashland, Ohio.

At 9:30 a.m. Public Comment

Larry Swander, Greenfield township trustee came before the board in regards to the host fee being eliminated for Greenfield Township, and why and referred to the Ohio Revised Code. Mr. Welch explained the fee and how it came about, and Mr. Welch stated that we have paid that fee for the last 10 years since the landfill has been closed and have not had to do so. The county maintains the road and the

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reason for eliminating this host fee is that the county is tight on funds. It was decided that Gary Bauer and Pete Welch will attend the next Greenfield township trustee meeting to discuss this as they had originally intended to do.

<u>At 9:37 a.m.</u> Mike Adelman moved to enter into **Executive Session ORC 121.22** (G) (3) a conference with an attorney for the public body concerning disputes involving the public body that are the subject of pending or imminent court action. Gary W. Bauer seconded the motion. The role being called upon its adoption, the vote resulted as follows:

At 9:42 a.m. Sue Bommer, HR came before the board to present the letters going out for open enrollment and had a few questions. One was in regards to the \$1300 for employees not taking the insurance and questioned the pay off being paid in November. Ms. Bommer explained that if one of these employees had a qualifying event such as a change in statues they could come back on the insurance. Ms. Bommer would like to suggest changing the procedure for this as a monthly payment. Ms. Bommer also stated that this is going to have to come out of department salary lines and there is nothing in salary lines to cover this expense. It was decided to go ahead and address the salary line at the end of the year and the board agreed to the monthly payment rather than a payment in November.

<u>At 9:50 a.m.</u> Sheriff Howard, Lenora Minor, CESA, and Auditor Roland Tkach came before the board in regards to the Title IV contract as the sheriff stated that he had some questions in regards to the grant and how the funding would work. Discussion was had in regards to the funds coming into the general fund and not being appropriated to the sheriff's budget as Mr. Tkach explained the estimated certificate of funds situation. After this discussion it will be researched as to whether a special fund can be established for these funds.

At 10:00 a.m. Tim Kwiatkowski/State Scenic Rivers Program/ODNR came before the board for a presentation of the Ohio Division of Natural Areas and Preserves Wild River Designation Criteria. The presented explained that in order to commence with a Wild, Scenic or recreational River study the Ohio Scenic Rivers Program must first receive resolution of support from the majority of political subdivisions through which the candidate river or stream flows. Rivers to be studied should represent those that are free of impoundments and generally inaccessible with watersheds and shorelines essentially undeveloped and waters unpolluted. Such steams shall exemplify natural healthy aquatic and riparian ecosystems. Prior to undertaking a detailed study staff shall undertake a preliminary investigations of the existing riparian corridor, aquatic species and water quality data to determine if further study is advisable. Mr. Bauer stated that he knows of one township that may have some concerns about this and would like to talk with them before making any decisions.

At 10:59 a.m. Mike Adelman moved to adjourn. Gary W. Bauer seconded the motion. The meeting stood adjourned.
