At 9:15 a.m. Pete Welch, Maintenance Supervisor, came before the board to discuss the air-conditioning unit at the Huron County Office Building that cools the Auditor's Office, third floor. Mr. Welch stated that the board has three possible options to solve this problem. Number 1 is to replace the compressor of the existing unit which would cost \$1,700.00. Larry Silcox requested information regarding the Steiner tractor being placed on GovDeals to sell. Cheryl Nolan will check to see what the status of this is. Mr. Silcox also mentioned an emailed received in

regards to an economic development meeting to be held in July.

Mike Adelman reported that the Huron County Fair Board is researching the possibility of selling beer at the Huron County fair. Mr. Adelman thought maybe one or two of the board members would come to this meeting today. Mr. Adelman stated that there is a fair board meeting tonight and he would like to be able to tell them that the Huron County Commissioners are not in favor of selling beer at the fair. The board discussed the fact that this should be done at adult events and that there are just too many kids involved at the fair and that this sends the wrong message to the kids. Mr. Bauer and Mr. Silcox agreed and further discussion was had in regards to the grants that the Sheriff has applied for educational programming in regards to alcohol and drug use. Mr. Adelman stated that he has also spoken to the sheriff and he is not in favor of selling beer at the fair either. Mr. Adelman will report this back to the fair board tonight. Mr. Adelman stated that an email had been received in regards to the foyer energy project at the courthouse. Need to go through a different website for federal guidelines to submit. Alex Beres, HCDC, will be contacted to pursue this for the board.

At 11:45 a.m. Larry J. Silcox moved to adjourn. Mike Adelman seconded the motion. The meeting stood adjourned.
